Mission of Mercy (M.O.M) is a mobile medical clinic established in 1997 as a source of help for those who don't qualify for medical insurance or who simply can't afford it. All medical care and prescriptions are provided free-of-charge and we don't ask our patients to prove their poverty. More than 275 individuals from all walks of life and experiences help serve our patients at five clinic locations throughout the Valley. M.O.M is 98% volunteer-driven and is proud of its low turnover rate.

Everyday, M.O.M. volunteers compassionately and patiently work with families to help them understand their medical conditions and encourage them to take preventive action to avoid costly complications and further illness.
